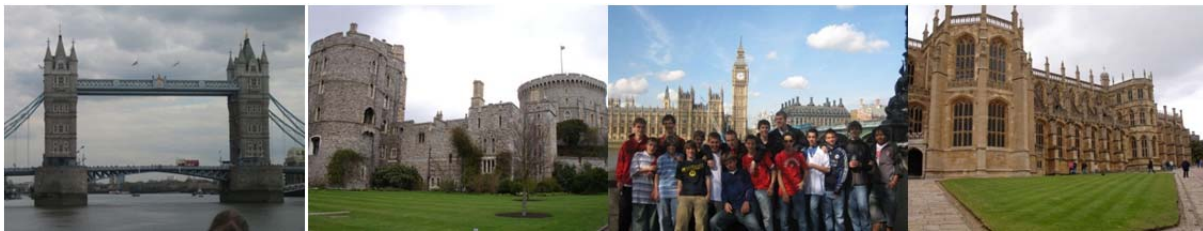


## Sight Seeing and Day Trips
